Dear Citizens of Payson,

A few months ago I approached the City Council about our aging police vehicle fleet. I asked the Council for \$210,000.00 to replace 5 vehicles and the equipment that goes into each. We currently have vehicles ranging in years from 2001 to 2007, some of which, despite the best efforts of our city shops, are in bad shape. We need to rotate 4 or 5 vehicles a year to keep them in the condition required of police service vehicles. The City Council asked me to explore the possibility of leasing the fleet. When all was said and done, the City Council approved a lease agreement with Ken Garff Ford in American Fork. This program will cost less than \$150,000.00 per year for the entire fleet (18 vehicles) and the necessary equipment for each vehicle. I am grateful to the City Council for making a tough decision in difficult economic times. I appreciate the support that our City Council and our citizens have shown for the police department.
