UDOT AREA PROJECTS**I-15 Bridge Deck Repairs & Shoulder****Reconstruction:**

The project will reconstruct the drainage structure at the Spanish Fork River, reconstruct the outside shoulders on I-15 in both directions from the Spanish Fork River to Santaquin, repair bridges at State Road 164 in Benjamin and Main and Center Streets in Santaquin, and the replace right-of-way fence along I-15.

I-15 Pavement Rehabilitation:

This project will remove and replace approximately 9.5 miles of asphalt and make repairs to four bridges on I-15 from Utah County to Nephi.

Motorists should expect reduced traffic lanes and speed limits. UHP has been conducting enforcement operations in the area. Drivers are encouraged to watch their speed. Visit www.udot.utah.gov for more information.
